Instructions for Student Presentation

Each team will give a maximum 5-minute presentation on *a practical experience of one member* in food biodiversity. Practical experience means e.g., an internship, a visit to a company, a volunteer activity. It is something that you did or someplace that you went and not something you studied or read about. The team should decide together which member will give the presentation.

- 1. Begin your presentation by introducing your experience. When and where did it occur?
- 2. Describe some facts about the experience. What did you do or see there?
- **3.** Offer some insights you gained from this experience. What was most interesting and why? What knowledge and skills did you gain?
- **4.** Finish with one slide that introduces your team and your project.

If no one on the team has any practical experience, one of the team members should visit a food biodiversity-related site in the coming 2 weeks.

Note that the maximum 5-minute presentation time will be strictly enforced. Please rehearse your presentation to be sure it does not exceed 5 minutes. You should not have more than 5 slides total (including the 1 slide to introduce your team and your project).
