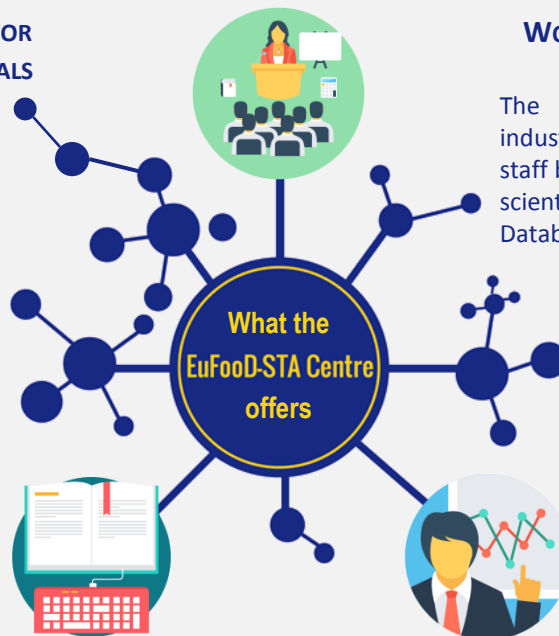
The **Digital Library** is a collection of online materials available in a web-based database that offers digital material for the food sector.
